




CUSTOMER ALLERGY INCIDENT REPORT

The purpose of the restriction to professional use as outlined in the Guidance Notes of the Restriction to “Professional Use” in the Cosmetics Directive 76/768/EEC Version 1.0 (December 2005)

The main objective of the Cosmetics Directive is safeguarding public health while ensuring the free market for cosmetic products.

In order to attain this objective the Cosmetics Directive exhaustively harmonises the labelling provisions for products placed on the Community market.

The Cosmetics Directive also regulates ingredients of cosmetic products through banning, restricting or authorising.

The restriction to professional use contributes to this objective; it ensures that products which:

- contain certain substances or
- contain substances in a higher concentration than for general use or
- do not contain certain warnings which are obligatory when used by the consumer are used by a professional only.

A professional is generally assumed to have a certain degree of professional Education and/or professional experience. In particular, a professional usually:

- is more familiar with the risks for health of a specific substance or its concentration in a cosmetic product than a consumer;
- has more expertise (eg professional expertise) in applying cosmetic products correctly on the consumer – this is in particular the case for substances which are used on the nails or on the hair but which must not get in contact with the skin; and disposes of more information on the product/its ingredients.

Finally, it is usually easier to inform professional users than the general public about the correct use of a cosmetic product.
